

**ADDENDUM TO RULE #28 SELECTIONS OF GRAND CHAMPION,  
INTERMEDIATE HIGH POINT, BEGINNER HIGH POINT OR TITLES**

**Page 17 Effective October 1, 2010**

E. All titles (Local, State, Regional and National) will be done on a point system. Not all events are used at all contests.

Solo

1<sup>st</sup> place            200

2<sup>nd</sup> place            194

3<sup>rd</sup> place            188

Each additional place decreases by 6 points

Fancy Strut

1<sup>st</sup> place            200

2<sup>nd</sup> place            196

3<sup>rd</sup> place            192

Each additional place decreases by 4 points

Show Presentation & Basic if required (Mini Nationals)

1<sup>st</sup> place            100

2<sup>nd</sup> place            97

3<sup>rd</sup> place            94

Each additional place decreases by 3 points

Interview, Interview Suit Modeling and Dress/Gown

1<sup>st</sup> place            100

2<sup>nd</sup> place            98

3<sup>rd</sup> place            96

Each additional place decreases by 2 points

All non-title event contestant's scores will be excluded and the title contestant scores will be moved up to the correct placement.

Solo placement will break all ties. If still tied after solo then it will go down to Fancy Strut to break the tie.

All scores that are required for a specific title are totaled and the winner is the one with the highest overall score.

**Adult Champion Event:**

Solo                    2Baton                    3Baton/Multiple batons

1<sup>st</sup> place 200

2<sup>nd</sup> place 194

3<sup>rd</sup> place 188

Each additional place decreases by 6 points

All scores are added together to determine the winner. Solo score will break any ties.

1. If contestants enter for two titles and win both titles, then they must accept the higher of the two titles.
2. The only exception is that a contestant can win both the Sr. Queen or Majorette Queen of America and the Adult Champion if they are eligible by age.
