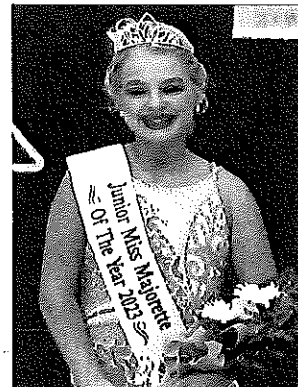

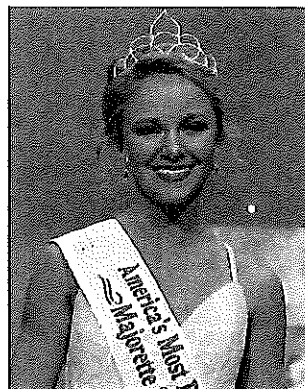

GENERAL INFORMATION

MINI NATIONAL TITLES ARE: Mini National Sweetheart (Beginner Title), Mini National Princess (Intermediate Title), Mini National Starlet (Special Beginner Title), Mini National All Star Twirler and Mini National All Star Twirler Elite. Eligibility is the same as for Miss Majorette of the Year titles.

For all Title Events, you must enter Solo, Fancy Strutting and Basic Strutting. No Modeling is required.

IMPORTANT NOTE: You may enter for two titles according to the DMA Rule Book, however, you may only receive one of these titles as an award. You will be awarded the highest level title. (NOTE: This does not concern twirling or strutting—you may win awards in both levels in these events.) Advanced contestants may not enter the Elite Category. You must earn the right to be an Elite contestant. To compete for All Star Twirler/Elite Title you must do All Star 2 Baton/Elite 2 Baton, All Star 3 Baton/Elite 3 Baton, All Star Solo Twirl/Elite. Combined conversion score will determine the winner. We are offering a Beg/Int Division also.

ELIGIBILITY FOR AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL MAJORETTE TITLES: These events are open to any DMA MEMBER without prior qualification. Contestants for these titles must enter one twirling and one strutting event—these must be Special Beginner, Beginner, Intermediate or Championship events. Scores earned in twirling and strutting are NOT used to determine the winner, but it is necessary to show that the contestant is a Majorette. Contestants for Most Beautiful Titles are judged on physical beauty, poise, personality, projection, modeling and their attire.

Contestants will model in pretty dress of their choice either long or short except for 15 & over contestants who will wear long dresses. There will be no interview.

MISS POM GIRL contestants will perform their routine to "Jai Ho" by the Pussycat Dolls

Awards: 1st - 5th Trophies.

Adult Mini National Champion - 20+

You must enter ADULT 1 Baton Solo Routine, ADULT 2 Baton and ADULT 3 Batons.

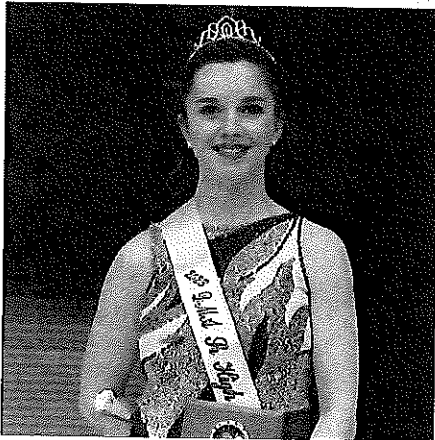

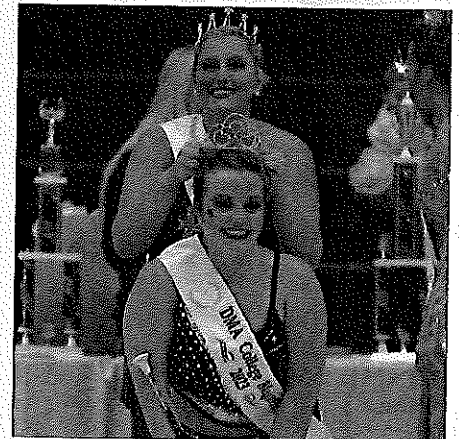

PLACE: Walker Valley High School, Cleveland, Tennessee

To be eligible to enter these events, a contestant must be attending high school (9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grades) for high school titles.

To enter junior high school events, a contestant must be in the 6th, 7th, 8th or 9th grade of a junior high or middle school.

(NOTE: In some areas the 9th grade can be either high school or junior high. A 9th grader could enter either level depending on what your school is called. Contestants MAY NOT enter both levels.)

Contestants must present a half-time show routine which consists of twirling one, two, or more (batons, hoops, flags, puffs, ribbons or streamers). No fire or knives are permitted. The routine is show-style and will include both twirling and strutting, including dance steps, all of which must be performed to instrumental music furnished by the contestant. (Music which includes vocal is NOT acceptable). 16 basic march steps are required in the routine. Failure to do so will result in a two point penalty. Also, there is a two point penalty for not using instrumental music. Time limit is between 3 and 4 minutes.

These events will be presented in Elite category also. If you are Elite in any other event you will be Elite in these events.

AWARDS: 1st through 5th place trophies-Banner, Crown and Flowers to first place.

DMA College Majorette

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS EVENT, you must be attending an accredited college or university as a full time student: You must have enrolled in the fall term (August or September) and have been in regular attendance since entering the college.

You must be between the ages of 18 and 23 and never have been married.

Contestants must present a halftime show routine which consists of novelty twirling (two or more batons, hoop, flag, puff, ribbon or streamer). No fire or knives are permitted. The routine is show-style and will include both twirling and strutting, including dance steps, all of which must be performed to instrumental music furnished by the contestant. (Music which includes vocal is NOT acceptable). 16 basic march steps are required in the routine. Failure to do so will result in a two point penalty. Also, there is a two point penalty for not using instrumental music. Time limit is between 3 and 4 minutes.

An interview will be held with each contestant in performance costume during basic strut.

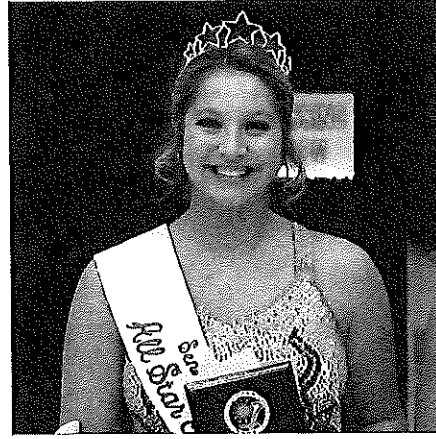

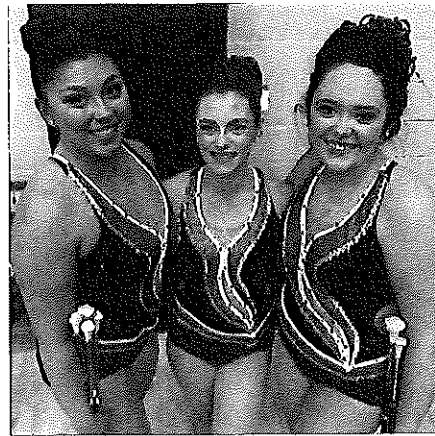
