- FACILITY:** Camp will be held on the campus Erskine College
Campers will have their meals in the college cafeteria and will be lodged in air-conditioned dorms. Dorms will have 2 students to a room and will utilize a community bath. There are washers and dryers available for FREE.
- WHO MAY ATTEND:** Anyone age 8 and over may attend. *A younger child may attend if their mother also attends. Mothers may attend camp if they wish (see special rate). Teachers not on staff may attend for a special rate and take part if they are a CURRENT DMA teacher. Other teachers may attend but must pay full camp rate.
- SUPERVISION:** All campers will be supervised by trained, experienced counselors. Parents will stay in the same dorms. Campers will be supervised at all times.
- WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING:** Shorts, sport clothes, tennis shoes, socks, batons, personal articles, bedding (twin extra-long) including sheets, pillow and blanket, towels, wash cloths, soap and all toiletries. We also suggest a notebook and pen.
- INSTRUCTION:** Classes are divided according to individual abilities. Larger classes will be divided, or an extra assistant instructor will be added to see that each student receives the personal attention needed.
- ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES:** Live in campers will need to check in between 3:00-5:00 PM on Sunday June 9. Check-in will be in the lobby of our Carnegie Hall (same as last year) . Day campers will need to check in at 8:15 AM Monday morning June 10 at the gym. Check out will be at noon on Thursday June 13 after the noon meal. If not staying for noon meal please let us know.
- PRIVATE LESSONS:** Private instruction is available at an extra charge from ALL instructors. Arrangements should be made directly with them when you check in.
- REGISTRATION:** A deposit of ½ your fee is due with the application. It MUST be a money order or cashier's check. NO PERSONAL checks. Balance is due in cash upon arrival. Make money order or bank check to Drum Majorettes of America. Credit card machine will be available.
