SPECIAL INFORMATION:

Modeling for all events will be done in a "T" pattern. Contestants for Most Beautiful, Queen of Day, and Title Events will be in "Dress of your choice".

NOTE: Contestants in **Queen of Day** will stay in their dresses until judges have chosen a "**Classic Queen**" from among the first place winners. Classic Queen will be awarded a Nice Trophy and Banner.

Contestants who enter for Special Beginner, Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced and Elite Titles must model as shown above and must be entered in Solo and Fancy Strut in the category appropriate to the title they seek.

Contestants for Most Beautiful **MUST** be entered in one SOLO and one STRUTTING event on any level. You do not have to do All-Star Title to enter All-Star Solo or All Star 2/3 batons.

Membership in DMA is required for contestants who enter for ALL TITLES and for MOST BEAUTIFUL events. Non-membership fee will be \$3.00 per event.

JR., SR. CLASSIC HALFTIME, ELITE AND CLASSIC COLLEGIATE HALFTIME, BEG/INT HALFTIME To be eligible, you must be attending

High School (9, 10, 11, 12) OR be a twirler with your high school band. If you are Elite in Solo competition, you must enter the Elite Category. You must present a Halftime Show Routine which should consist of novelty twirling, 2 baton, 3 baton, hoop, flag, or streamers, etc. -. (No fire, knives) and show style twirling and strutting including dance steps choreographed to the instrumental music (NO vocals). You must provide your CD. You must do at least 16 march steps during your routine.

CLASSIC BEG/INT HALFTIME- You must be a Special Beginner, Beginner or Intermediate twirler to enter this event. Same requirements as Halftimes. 1 age division only. You may NOT enter 2 Halftime events. Awards: 1st - 5th Trophies. Banners and Flowers.

MISS POM GIRL A Pom/Dance routine is done to the music chosen by DMA (see the website after Nationals) with a time limit of 1 to 1 ½ minutes. Poms must be kept in hands at all times. The only gymnastics permitted are cartwheels/walkovers, splits and floor movements. Judging is based on coordination of poms with body movements, choreography with music, audience appeal, execution, showmanship and overall general effect and enthusiasm. Banners to First Place Winners.

FALL CLASSIC ALL-STAR TITLE & ALL STAR TITLE ELITE-Must compete in All-Star solo, All-Star 2 & All-Star 3 baton Banner & crown Ages-(0-10), (11-14), (15-23) Elite (10-12) (13-15) (16-23) May also compete in regular titles. 1st-5th awards

RULES
